

# NEW CHURCH ENTRY AND OFFICE CONCEPT TO COMPLETION St Peter's Church, Box Hill

This Melbourne Anglican Church was designed by Louis Williams and built 60 years ago. It is prominently located between Box Hill Town Hall and Library. This extension sits forward of the original building to provide a church office and new entry including ramp access.

Design features include:

- Ribbed copper roof radiating from the original curved baptistry
- ESD principles of shading in Summer and passive solar heating in Winter
- Visible activity within the church demonstrated to passers-by through the use of glazing
- Long baptistry windows lighting maintained internally by glazed panel in copper roof
- Translucent blinds provide privacy when required
