

STUDENT & TEACHING ACCOMMODATION
CONCEPT TO COMPLETION

Having won a design competition for 100 new student accommodation units, Fred Batterton and Christopher Kubale were retained by this university college to carry out a number of projects over many years. These included:

- Adaptation of Jackson Building and other heritage listed main campus buildings to create teaching facilities and student housing. This was carried out sequentially as a series of fast-track projects. The challenge was to match the college's needs with the heritage building layout
- Adaptation & restoration of Sir John Soane's Senior Common Room to meet new college requirements
- Kitchens and servery upgrade
- New gatehouse and campus replanning at Frewin Hall. Adaptation and upgrade of heritage listed buildings to campus perimeter to provide student accommodation
- Extension of G2* heritage building to create 25 new student rooms
- Upgrade to C20th listed student accommodation by Powell & Moya
